ABOUT THE PERFORMER

Ivan Linford has been the Organist at Oakham School since September 2003. He was formerly Assistant Director of Music at Leicester Cathedral and Director of Music at Oakham Parish Church. He holds the degrees of Bachelor of Music and Master of Arts from the University of Huddersfield (where he developed an interest in contemporary music) and is an Associate of the Royal College of Organists. As a postgraduate student, he was Organ Scholar at Liverpool Metropolitan Cathedral where he was involved in the playing of the funeral service for Archbishop Derek Worlock. He began to learn the organ whilst still at school with Christopher Gower at Peterborough Cathedral, where he had previously been a chorister. He has given organ recitals at various English cathedrals, as well as the Caird Hall, Dundee and the Parr Hall, Warrington. As an accompanist, he has performed in various venues in this country, as well as in Ireland, France, Belgium, Hungary and the USA. He has made several TV appearances as a musician including *Songs of Praise*, but has recently made a rather different appearance as a contestant on the BBC TV quiz show *Weakest Link* (he was the last person to be ‘voted off!’).

ABOUT MUSIC IN THE CHURCH

Holy Trinity is a church of high Anglican tradition with a strong congregation and place in the local community. Sunday and feast-day masses are led by choir and organ, in addition to which carol services are sung at Christmas and Easter. We regularly join with friends and musicians from other congregations for larger services. The choir currently has vacancies for a small number of voices. Commitment is the only qualification required of all members, so why not come along and give it a go?
