Michael Wynne started playing music at an early age, beginning the pianoforte at 4, and later, at Bolton School for Boys, the organ. After leaving school he became organ scholar at Liverpool Cathedral, and then Manchester Cathedral and later Choral Director for the Diocese of Leeds. Michael studied with David Titterington at the Royal Academy of Music, and improvisation with David Briggs, Olivier Latry and Naji Hakim.

Michael is Director of Music at St. Mary's Priory, Warrington. He also works on a freelance basis for Opera Box and the charity Music in Hospitals. He is in demand as a recitalist, accompanist, teacher and conductor and has played at many major venues in this country, and an increasing number in Europe. Tours have included Prague, Paris, Belgium, the Netherlands, and most recently, Normandy.
